Typical questions property owners should ask a company wanting to place a permanent pipeline on your land. These can be modified to suit your location.

Abbreviation **Gas Corp** is used below for any reference to a natural gas company or a pipeline subsidiary to a natural gas company. These subsidiaries are frequently called Midstream Companies. They will do the pipelines, gas processing and some compressor stations on behalf of natural gas companies.

- 1. What will **Gas Corp** be allowed to do, short term and long term?
- 2. What will **Gas Corp** not be allowed to do, short term and long term?
- 3. What will **Gas Corp** be required to do?
- 4. What will **Gas Corp** be required to not do?
- 5. What is the absolute minimum distance this pipe will be placed away from any dwelling anywhere along its entire length?
- 6. What restrictions will there be on my use of my land after you put in the pipes?
- 7. Who will be overseeing and enforcing any environmental restrictions, e.g. erosion and sedimentation; slips; stream crossings; etc.?
- 8. Who will be responsible for my access road upkeep?
- 9. Who will be responsible for long term slips and settlements of surface?
- 10. When would this construction begin?
- 11. When would all work be completed?
- 12. Who would be responsible for long-term stability of my land?
- 13. Will the pipeline contractor(s) be bound to any of our agreements?
- 14. Who will the pipeline contractor(s) be?
- 15. What is the complete list of the types of materials that will be transported in the pipe?
- 16. Will there be more than one pipe buried?
- 17. How wide will the temporary work right-of-way be?
- 18. How wide will the permanent right-of-way be?
- 19. How deep will the pipes be buried?
- 20. What size pipe will it be; what wall thickness?
- 21. How often will the welds on the individual pipe segments be inspected?
- 22. Will there be any above ground pipeline components left visible?
- 23. Where will the pipe(s) originate and where all will they go?
- 24. What will the average operating pressure be?
- 25. What will the absolute maximum pressure ever be?
- 26. Will all pipeline and excavating and laying equipment be brought in clean and totally free from any invasive species?
- 27. How will the disturbed soil be reclaimed?
- 28. Will all top soil be kept separate and replaced after the pipeline is buried?
- 29. Please provide a Plain English translation of your landowner initial contract.
- 30. At this pressure and diameter, what is the PIR—Potential Impact Radius?
- 31. Also, after all the above is settled, how much will I be paid per linear foot of pipeline?
