- BUILDING TRADES: BEAMS, CAPS AND BARRIERS

These trainings will be offered twice a year for the next 2 years. In order to gain certificates and be considered a graduate of the program you must sign up and complete at least 3 courses that are offered! ONE of those courses HAS TO BE **HAZWOPER**. Upon completion there will be help in obtaining a position at a company that provides the type of work and services these trainings are necessary for! We will work to place you in employment, but employment is not guaranteed.

Trainings will mainly take place in Huntington, WV at the West Edge Factory location as well as some taking place on Campus at Marshall and other local community colleges.
