

DEP to Hold Public Meeting

The West Virginia Department of Environmental Protection's Division of Air Quality (DAQ), pursuant to §45-13-9, will hold a public meeting on Wednesday, March 27, to provide information and receive comments regarding Blue Racer Midstream, LLC's air quality permit application. Blue Racer Midstream has proposed modifications to their Natrium Extraction and Fractionation Plant located at 14787 Energy Road, Proctor, Marshall County at latitude 39.75996 and longitude -80.86101.

The public meeting will be held at the New Martinsville City Hall, 191 Main Street, New Martinsville, at 6 p.m. Representatives from the DAQ will conduct the meeting regarding the modification application initially submitted by Blue Racer Midstream on August 7, 2018, and revised on January 16, 2019.
